Student Driving Agreement

Violation of the Timberlake transportation policy can result in loss of driving privileges for a given length of time, suspension from class, or a fine. Parking in the student parking lot is a privilege and may be withdrawn at the administration's discretion.

Student parking is allowed only in the designated "Student Parking Area" shown on the back of the student manual. Do not park in unmarked spaces, enter/exit lanes, fire lanes, or handicapped spaces without a handicap permit (or the city will issue a fine).

The school is not responsible for vehicle damage or theft, although we will assist to resolve these problems. If an accident occurs, be sure to exchange insurance information, driver's licenses and vehicle information with the other driver(s).

Accepting a student parking permit is an agreement to the following:

1. **Your parking permit must be visibly displayed on your rearview mirror at all times.**
2. Absences or tardies due to vehicle complications (car trouble, running out of gas, etc.) will ***not*** be excused, because bus transportation is an available alternative.
3. Cars are to be parked in the student parking lot with doors locked.
4. Once you have arrived at school, you are not allowed to leave school grounds, except during lunch (if permitted) or if the office has been notified by a parent. ***Leaving school at lunchtime in a vehicle is not recommended.***
5. Lack of courtesy toward other drivers when entering/exiting the parking lot will result in loss of driving/parking privileges.
6. All student vehicles parked on the grass or curbs, visitor or faculty parking lots during regular school hours ***will be issued a fine.***
7. Improper parking, reckless driving, speeding, riding in the back of a pickup and horseplay are very dangerous. This kind of conduct will not be tolerated and may lead to loss of parking privileges and/or discipline.
8. The parking lot is off limits to students during class time and students may not sit in their cars in the parking lot or loiter in the parking lot before or after school hours.
9. If a student receives a fine, **all driving/parking privileges will be suspended until the fine is paid.**
10. Vehicles will be searched if there is cause to suspect that school policies have been violated.
11. NO WEAPONS, including hunting guns, are allowed in student vehicles.
12. Exchanging parking permits with other students will result in loss of parking privileges AND you will be held liable for any parking violation or fines incurred by that individual.
